Re: Safe Drinking Water Act, O. Reg. 170/03 Schedule 22 Summary Report

Enclosed is the 2019 Summary Report for the Amherstburg Water Treatment Plant. This report has been completed based on the information obtained from the water treatment plant records and in accordance with Schedule 22 of O. Reg. 170/03, under the Safe Drinking Water Act, which requires a Summary Report to be prepared not later than March 31st of each year for the preceding calendar year. This report covers the period of January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019.

Please remember that any Orders that you have received directly from the MECP should be reviewed. Note: Schedule 22-2 (a) specifies that the summary report is given to, in the case of a drinking water system owned by a municipality, the members of the municipal council for the Town of Amherstburg, and is not intended for distribution to the Ministry of the Environment.

This report is a summary of water quality information for the Amherstburg WTP, published in accordance with Schedule 22 of Ontario's Drinking-Water Systems Regulation for the reporting period of January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019. The Amherstburg WTP is categorized as a Large Municipal Residential Drinking Water System.

This report was prepared by The Ontario Clean Water Agency on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg.

The report must,

By comparison found in table 2, the raw water and treated water flows did not exceed the legislative requirement. The treated flow was 65% of the rated capacity for the reporting period.
