The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg "Breast Cancer Awareness Month - October 2019"

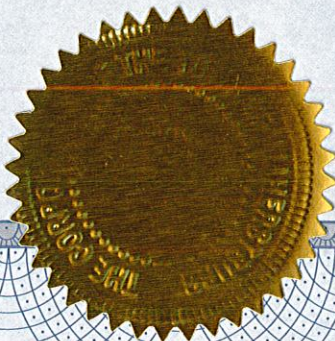
Where as: Breast Cancer Awareness Month will be recognized in October 2019 in the Town of Amherstburg; and,


Where as: Breast Cancer affects 1 in 8 Canadian women, approximately 70 Canadians per day. During Breast Cancer Awareness Month we recognize the families who courageously fight to survive, detect, prevent, treat, and support survivors of breast cancer, and we honour those of whom we have lost to this battle, as well as their grieving families; and,

Where as: Windsor Regional Hospital Foundation is working in partnership with the Hospital's Breast Health Centre and Diagnostic Imaging Department to raise vital funds for a new 3D Digital Mammography machine for the Windsor/Essex County region. Windsor Regional Hospital has conducted over 85,000 breast screenings over the past 5 years. New 3D Digital Mammography technology will enable our clinicians to improve the accuracy of breast cancer screenings, reduce the number of false positive tests, and improve women's health in our region; and,

I, Therefore, Proclaim that the month of October be observed as "Breast Cancer Awareness Month" in the Town of Amherstburg. I further urge all citizens to support preventative diagnostic technology and the improvement of preventative breast cancer screenings in our community.
