

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 1998-03

A by-law to appoint a Chief Administrative Officer for the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg

WHEREAS Section 72 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M45 authorizes Council to appoint a Chief Administrative Officer;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable and in the best interests of the administration of the government and affairs of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg to appoint a Chief Administrative Officer;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF
THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. WILLIAM KING is hereby appointed to be the Chief Administrative Officer of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg.
2. As Chief Administrative Officer, William King shall have general control and management of the administration of the government and affairs of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg and shall be responsible for the efficient administration of all it's departments, except as limited by by-law of the Council.
3. The term of office of William King as Chief Administrative Officer shall commence January 1, 1998, and shall continue during the pleasure of the council until his resignation, retirement, or removal from office by by-law of the council, after a hearing by the council or a committee of the whole council, if requested, pursuant to Section 97(2) of The Municipal Act.
4. In the event of absence, through illness or otherwise of the Chief Administrative Officer, the Clerk, shall be the acting Chief Administrative Officer and shall have the powers and perform the duties of the Chief Administrative Officer.
5. By-law No. 2406 of the Town of Amherstburg, and all other by-laws not consistent with this By-law are hereby repealed.
6. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
