

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 1998-50

Being a By-law to appoint a Property Standards Committee.

WHEREAS a Council that has constituted a Committee of Adjustment may by By-law empower the Committee of Adjustment to grant minor variances from the provisions of any By-law of the municipality that implements an Official Plan, or from such By-laws of the municipality as are specified and that implement an Official, as provided for in The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, Ch. P13, Section 45(3);

AND WHEREAS By-laws 1414 and 2253 of the Town of Amherstburg, 2890 of the Township of Anderdon, and 8419 of the Township of Malden prescribed standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property;

AND WHEREAS Council has deemed it expedient to appoint a Property Standards Committee.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF
THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the following persons not being members of the Council or employees of the Corporation or of any local board or committee thereof, and duly eligible to hold this position by an applicable law or right, shall and are hereby appointed as members of the Property Standards Committee for the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg and shall hold office until December 1, 2000:
 1. David Cozens
 2. John West
 3. Terris Buchanan
 4. Donald Shaw
 5. Gerald Wismer
2. That the remuneration to be paid to the Committee members shall be \$50.00 each per meeting attended.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon final passage thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 27th day of July, 1998.
