

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 1998-70

**Being a by-law to issue and charge fees for licences to hunt
during the open season - Pheasants and Rabbits**

WHEREAS Section 44(1) of the Game and Fish Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that the Minister of Natural Resources may, in writing, authorize any Municipality to pass by-laws for issuing and fixing the maximum number of licences to hunt during the open season - pheasants and rabbits and for charging such fees therefore as he authorizes; the Minister may also fix the minimum number of such licences that the by-law shall provide for,

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That no person shall hunt pheasants and rabbits within the Town of Amherstburg in the County of Essex until a licence for that purpose has been obtained and such licences to be in addition to any other licence required by the Game and Fish Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
- (2) The Clerk of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg or other person or persons appointed from time to time by the Council shall issue and sell the following:
 - (a) a licence for non-residents of the Town of Amherstburg to hunt pheasants and rabbits at a fee of **\$5.00**
 - (b) a licence for residents of the Town of Amherstburg to hunt pheasants and rabbits at a fee of **\$3.00**.
- (3) The fee prescribed shall be paid for each licence when same is issued.
- (4) That for the purpose of the by-law, all Municipal licences issued within the County of Essex are non-reciprocate during the pheasant season but are reciprocate for rabbits upon closing of the pheasant season.
- (5) In this by-law, the words "Resident of the Town" means any person who is a farmer, land owner or tenant within the Town.
- (6) In this by-law, the words "Non-resident of the Town" means any person who does not own property or reside within the Town.
- (7) A minimum of 200 licences must be made available for use of non-residents and no restrictions on the number available to residents of the Town of Amherstburg.
- (8) The Licences are valid only in areas of the Town where hunting and/or the discharge of firearms is allowed.
- (9) That all previous by-laws passed by the Township of Malden, including By-law 97-22 and all previous by-laws passed by the Township of Anderdon including By-law 2596, which are inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.


It is also provided that this by-law does not apply to any land of the Crown and/or any land within the municipality, the owner of which has entered into an agreement under Section 6 of the Game and Fish Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of the final passing thereof subject to the Minister of Natural Resources authorizing in writing the passing of the by-law.


First and Second Reading - September 28, 1998
