

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 1999-59

Being a by-law to amend By-law 1999-11.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 210(89) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, authorizes Council to enter into a Contract with any person for the collection, removal and disposal of garbage and refuse upon such terms and conditions as may be considered expedient; and

WHEREAS the former Township of Malden had contracted D.W. Crowder Trucking to provide for the collection, removal and disposal of garbage and refuse; and

WHEREAS the contract continued after the amalgamation of Amherstburg, Malden and Anderdon, but has now expired; and

WHEREAS the Contractor is agreeable to extending the terms of the existing contract to June 30, 2000; and

WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to extend the existing contract as approved by By-Law 1999-11 to June 30, 2000, and make amendments thereto.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION

OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule "A" to By-Law 1999-11 is hereby amended as follows:

(a) That Clause (2), Term of Contract, be replaced in its entirety as follows:


"The period of the contract shall be from the 1st day of January 2000, and shall remain in force until June 30, 2000, or the contract could be terminated upon three (3) months written notice."


(b) That Clause (9), Fees, be replaced in its entirety as follows:

"The Corporation shall pay to the Collector for such garbage and rubbish collection, removal and disposal, the rate of \$ 4.35 per household collected, payable in regular monthly installments."

2. That this By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed on the 13th day of December, 1999.
