

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 2003-59

A by-law to close and stop up part of the unopened road allowance between Lots 55 and 56, Concession 5 in the Town of Amherstburg (formerly Township of Malden) in the County of Essex and in the Province of Ontario, as more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a by-law of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") as follows:

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, sections 31 and 34, authorizes the councils of municipalities to pass by-laws pertaining to the establishing of highways, and provides procedures for the closing of highways;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to close and stop up part of the road allowance between Lots 55 and 56, Concession 5, in the Town of Amherstburg, in the County of Essex, as more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto;

AND WHEREAS Notice of the intention of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg to pass this by-law was sent to the Council of the County of Essex and duly published in the Amherstburg Echo on the following days:


1. June 24th, 2003.
2. July 1st, 2003.
3. July 8th, 2003.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the part of the road allowance between Lots 55 and 56, Concession 5, in the Town of Amherstburg, in the County of Essex, as more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law be and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect after the final passing thereof on the day upon which it is registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Essex (No. 12).
3. That the Mayor and the Clerk of the Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to do all acts and sign all documents which will be necessary to sell and convey the said street so closed as provided herein, and to otherwise carry out the intent of this by-law.
