THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NUMBER 2007-36

Being a by-law to request the Minister of Natural Resources to repeal Township of Anderdon by-law 2596 and Township of Malden by-law 97-22 by-law which authorizes the issuance of licences to hunt ringed-necked pheasants, cottontails, varying hares and European hares

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 79(6) of The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act, Chapter 41, Statutes of Ontario 1997 the Minister may in writing authorize the repeal of a by-law authorizing the issuance of licences to hunt ringed-necked pheasants, cottontails, varying hares and European hares.

AND WHEREAS Township of Anderdon by-law 2596 and Township of Malden by-law 97-22 permits the issuance of hunting licences for ringed-necked pheasants, cottontails, varying hares and European hares.

AND WHEREAS the Council for the Town of Amherstburg deems it necessary in the interest of the residents of the municipality to discontinue the sale of licences to hunt ringed-necked pheasants, cottontails, varying hares and European hares.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Minister of Natural Resources be requested to repeal Township of Anderdon by-law 2596 and Township of Malden by-law 97-22 which authorizes the issuance of licences to hunt ringed-necked pheasants, cottontails, varying hares and European hares
- 2. That this by-law will come into force and effect upon the written permission of the Minister of Natural Resources.
- 3. That this by-law repeals all other by-laws passed under the authority of The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act.
