BYLAW NO. 2007-53

Being a Bylaw to appoint Lottery Licencing Officers

WHEREAS the Municipal Act provides that the Councils of all municipalities may pass bylaws for appointing such Officers and Servants as may be necessary for the purpose of the Corporation;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to appoint Lottery Licencing Officers;

- 1. That Town Clerk Pamela Malott is hereby appointed Lottery Licencing Officer for the Town of Amherstburg, and further that in the absence of the Town Clerk the Deputy Clerk Carol Bendo; and the Treasurer Paul Beneteau shall be authorized to exercise the same power and authority.
- 2. That the said Carol Bendo and Paul Beneteau and Pam Malott shall hold office during the pleasure of the Council and shall exercise all the authority, powers and rights and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by statue or bylaws are or may be conferred or imposed upon the Lottery Licencing Officer and any other duties that may be imposed by Council.
- 3. That Bylaw No. 2000-06 be hereby repealed.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
