Borrowing By-Law Of The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg

#### By-Law Number 2008-64

A by-law to raise money to aid in the construction of drainage works under the T*ile Drainage Act*.

The council, pursuant to the Tile Drainage Act, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Corporation may from time to time, subject to the provisions of the by-law, borrow on the credit of the Corporation such sums not exceeding in the whole <u>\$300,000</u> as may be determined by the council and may in manner hereinafter provided, issue debentures of the Corporation for the amount so borrowed as provided in the Act payable to the Minister of Finance at the Ministry of Treasury and Economics at Toronto, which debentures shall reserve the right to prepay the whole or any part of principal and interest owing at the time of such prepayment.
- 2. Where an application for a loan under the Act is approved by the council and the inspector of drainage has filed with the clerk an inspection and completion certificate, the council may include a sum, not exceeding the amount applied for or 75 per cent of the total cost of the drainage work with respect to which the loan is made, in a debenture payable to the Minister of Finance in accordance with the Act, and may approve of the Corporation lending the said sum to the applicant.
- 3. A special annual rate shall be imposed, levied and collected over and above all other rates upon the land in respect of which the money is borrowed, sufficient for the payment of the principal and interest as provided by the Act.

#### Being a By-law to provide for an Exemption Status regarding Kennel Licenses within the Town of Amherstburg.

Animal burial grounds, dog kennels and boarding kennels, in accordance with subsection 26(3)(1) of the By-law.

WHEREAS the Town of Amherstburg has issued three Kennel Licenses which are contrary to Section 26(2)(x) Zoning By-Law, Council resolves to provide for an exemption status pertaining to these three sites knows as:

500 Alma Street, Plan 590 Lots 8 to 10, RP 12R10615 Part 1 278 Lowes Side Road, Con 1 Pt Lot 4; RP 12R8122 Part 2 736 Richmond Street, Plan 12M374 Lot 6

A Schedule is attached hereto and forms part of this by-law indicating the three sites that qualify for such an exemption. This exemption will remain in force provided that no complaints are received with respect to the exempted sites. The exemption status will not transfer to new owners of the affected properties.

#### BY-LAW NUMBER ... 2008-67..

By-law imposing special annual drainage rates upon land in respect of which money is borrowed under the Tile Drainage Act.

Whereas owners of land in the municipality have applied to the council under the Tile Drainage Act, for loans for the purpose of constructing subsurface drainage works on such land; and whereas the council

has upon their application lent the owners the total sum of \$ ....37,500.00...... to be repaid with interest by means of rates hereinafter imposed:

Be it therefore enacted, by the council, that annual rates as set out in the Schedule attached hereto are hereby imposed upon such land as described for a period often years, such rates to be levied and collected in the same manner as taxes.
