

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 2011-34

Being a By-law to exempt from all or part of the taxes levied for municipal and school purposes land or a portion of it on which municipal capital facilities are located

WHEREAS The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg has built and owns the United Communities Credit Union Recreation Complex on lands situate in the Town of Amherstburg;


WHEREAS the United Communities Credit Union Recreation Complex is a class of municipal capital facility used for recreation purposes as defined by Ontario Regulation 603/06 for the purposes of section 110(6) of the Municipal Act, 2001, and is for public use;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg may exempt from all or part of the taxes levied for municipal and school purposes land or a portion of it on which municipal capital facilities are located;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to section 110 of the Municipal Act, 2001 and Ontario Regulation 603/06, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg enacts as follows:

1. Council may enter into agreements with persons in respect to the United Communities Credit Union Recreation Complex for the purpose of exempting those persons from municipal and school taxes provided the said agreement meets the conditions required by the said Act and regulation.
2. The exemption of those persons from municipal and school taxes shall be limited to those portions of the municipal capital facilities that comply with the provisions of the said Act and regulation.
3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 22 day of February, 2011.
