BY-LAW NO. 2012-27

A by-law to dedicate certain lands in the Town of Amherstburg as a Public Highway

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, c.25 Sections 24-68 authorizes the Council of every municipality to pass a by-law for establishing, laying out, acquiring, assuming, or naming a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Committee of Adjustment of the Town of Amherstburg granted a consent for purposes of a 66 ft. road allowance on August 26, 2008 to Boblo Island Developments Inc.;

AND WHEREAS land was previously transferred to the Town for River Walk Crescent described as follows:

Registered Plan 12R-23658, Parts 1, 2 and 3 Area 1.202 acres

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the lands described as Registered Plan 12R-23658, Parts 1, 2 and 3 with an area of 1.202 acres shown on "Schedule A" attached hereto, in the Town of Amherstburg, County of Essex, Province of Ontario is hereby established as a public roadway.
- 1. That this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the date of final passage.
