

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG
BY-LAW 2014-15**

**By-law to Provide for Reduced Hours of Voting
in Institutions and Retirement Homes on Voting Day
2014 Municipal Election**


WHEREAS Section 46(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") provides that on Voting Day, Monday October 27, 2014, voting places shall be open for the electors to vote from 10:00 am. to 8:00 pm.;

AND WHEREAS Section 46(3) of the Act provides that Council may pass a by-law providing for reduced opening hours in voting places in institutions or retirement homes as defined in Section 45(7) of the Act, where the voting place is only for the use of residents of the institution or retirement home;

NOW THEREFORE the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That the hours of voting stations at institutions and retirement homes where only residents of the retirement home and institution are eligible to vote shall be open for a minimum of two hours between the hours of 10:00 am. and 8:00 pm. on Monday, October 27, 2014, or until such time as an Officer of the Institution or Retirement Home as designated by the Returning Officer has determined with the Deputy Returning Officer that all eligible electors who wish to vote have been provided an opportunity to do so.
- 2) This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon final passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 23rd day of June, 2014.
