By-law to delegate authority to the Clerk to pursue and settle for the Indemnification of Emergency Response Fees for Fire Department Services

WHEREAS section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties to a person or body subject to the restrictions;

AND WHEREAS subsection 279(1) of the Municipal Act S. O. 2001, c. 25 as amended, provides that a municipality may be or act as an insurer;

AND WHEREAS Council desires to delegate authority for various administrative matters as set out herein to the Clerk;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg enacts as follows:

- THAT Paula Parker, Municipal Clerk / Risk Manager be delegated the authority to pursue and settle for the indemnification of emergency response fees charged for Fire Department Services as included in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- 2. THAT 50% of the funds recovered from insurance companies be transferred to the Insurance Reserve and 50% of the funds recovered be transferred to the Fire Reserve.
- 3. THAT the User Fee By-law be amended to include the fees captured in Schedule "A".
- 4. THAT this by-law come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
