Mayor Hurst advised that the purpose of this meeting was to discuss the proposed traffic signal at the intersection of Kingsbridge Drive and County Road 20.

In the afternoon of today's date Council had met with the various parties (developer, solicitor, residents, County of Essex) that had interest or concerns with the proposed traffic signal for the intersection of Kingsbridge Drive and County Road 20. Council then had meetings concerning Drainage Reports prepared under the Municipal Drainage Act and desired now to further discuss the proposed signalization.

A lengthy discussion took place regarding the various aspects of traffic flow volumes in relation to the possible location of traffic signals that could be considered for the area. Discussion led to the following resolutions being passed.
