Council met with the following residents who are requesting a 2" waterline on Knapp Island Road:

The residents explained that there would only be 5 houses at the most to service with water.

Mr. Faucher stated that the Vandenbrinks who live the farthest from County Road 20 do not wish to have municipal water for their hog operation.

Mayor Hurst explained that generally 2" waterlines are not the best long range option, however, Council considers all requests individually.

After discussion on the water, the following resolution was passed:

Moved by R. Pillon, seconded by G. Theriault that we proceed with the request for a 2" waterline on Knapp Island Road with the following conditions:

- Agreement from George Vanderbrink that he will not require water for his hog operation (registered on title).
- Confirmation from the Town Engineers that drawings can be prepared in order to obtain M.O.E. approval of the project.
- Approval from the County of Essex to cross County Road 20 with the Waterline.
- Project to be completed by the Town Public Works Department.
- That easements for the watermain be obtained from the owners.

It was requested that the Property Standards Officer check into the condition of the Bob-lo House on Highway 20.


PROPERTY AT CORNER OF SIXTH CONCESSION (ANDERDON) AND THE ANDERDON
