By-law to Delegate Authority to the Clerk to pursue and Settle with Third Parties for the Recovery of Town Property Damage Claims

WHEREAS section 270 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties to a person or body subject to the restrictions;

AND WHEREAS subsection 279(1) of the Municipal Act S. O. 2001, c. 25 as amended, provides that a municipality may be or act as an insurer;

AND WHEREAS Council desires to delegate authority for various administrative matters as set out herein to the Clerk;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the Clerk of the Town of Amherstburg be delegated the authority to pursue and settle with third parties for the recovery of Town property damage claims.
- 2. THAT all funds recovered from third parties be transferred to the Insurance reserve to fund future claims/
- 3. THAT By-law 2016-15 be hereby repealed.
- 4. THAT this by-law come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
