By-law No. 2021-060

**By-law to Delegate Authority to the Clerk to pursue and Settle with
Third Parties for the Recovery of Town Property Damage Claims**

WHEREAS section 270 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties to a person or body subject to the restrictions;

AND WHEREAS subsection 279(1) of the *Municipal Act* S. O. 2001, c. 25 as amended, provides that a municipality may be or act as an insurer;

AND WHEREAS Council desires to delegate authority for various administrative matters as set out herein to the Clerk;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Clerk of the Town of Amherstburg be delegated the authority to pursue and settle with third parties for the recovery of Town property damage claims.
2. THAT all funds recovered from third parties be transferred to the Insurance reserve to fund future claims/
3. THAT By-law 2016-15 be hereby repealed.
4. THAT this by-law come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
