The Mayor called the meeting to order at 5:07 p.m.

PRESENTATION BY ADMINISTRATION/PLANNING CONSULTANT

3.1 Public Meeting to consider a Temporary Use Zoning By-law Amendment for 310 Thomas Road

The Manager of Planning Services provided Council an overview of the Temporary Use Zoning By-law Amendment for 310 Thomas Road.

PRESENTATION BY THE APPLICANT

Jackie Lassaline, Planning Consultant, Crozier Baird, addressed Council on behalf of Don Hearn and Sons, with respect to considering a temporary use zoning by-law to allow Don Hearn and Sons to crush concrete and asphalt at 310 Thomas Road.

Mike Recchia, CFO, Don Hearn and Sons, addressed Council to ask for their consideration with respect to considering the temporary used zoning by-law.

PUBLIC INPUT

Greg Nemeth addressed Council with his concerns regarding the affects of the proposed crushing.

RESPONSE FROM THE APPLICANT

There was no response from the applicant.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION

Discussion ensued with respect crushing concrete and asphalt at 310 Thomas Road.

Tim Bryne and Dan Lebedyk, ERCA, answered Council's questions with respect to crushing existing materials at 310 Thomas Road. Mr. Bryne stated that a temporary crushing by-law, rather than a long term by-law, is the best solution to removing the existing material.

- 3. Pending Council consideration of written and oral comments received that By-law 2015-42 being a by-law to permit the temporary use of the site located at 310 Thomas Road as a Waste Disposal Site, BE CONSIDERED at the regular council meeting following this public meeting.
