Attached is the 2014 Summary Report for the Amherstburg Water Treatment Plant. This report has been completed based on the information obtained from the water treatment plant records and in accordance with Schedule 22 of O. Reg. 170/03, under the Safe Drinking Water Act, which requires a Summary Report to be prepared not later than March 31st of each year for the preceding calendar year. This report covers the period of January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

ANNUAL SUMMARY REPORT FOR THE AMHERSTBURG WTP

This report is a summary of water quality information for the Amherstburg WTP, published in accordance with Schedule 22 of Ontario's Drinking-Water Systems Regulation for the reporting period of January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014. The Amherstburg WTP is categorized as a Large Municipal Residential Drinking Water System.

This report was prepared by The Ontario Clean Water Agency on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg.

The report must,

- (a) list the requirements of the Act, the regulations, the system's approval and any order that the system failed to meet at any time during the period covered by the report and specify the duration of the failure; and
- (b) for each failure referred to in clause (a), describe the measures that were taken to correct the failure.

By comparison, the raw water and treated water flows did not exceed the legislative requirement. The treated flow was 65% of the rated capacity for the reporting period.
