Purpose

To provide Council with the 2014 budget estimates for External Commitments.

Discussion

The External Commitments section is comprised of those programs provided by external agencies for services delivered to the benefit of ratepayers of the County of Essex. The commitments are categorized as legislated, long-term discretionary, current discretionary and discretionary grants.

Prior Year Performance

Net requests for prior year are projected to be in a favourable position of approximately \$709,000, as at December 31, 2013. The savings from budget in social assistance caseloads, social housing costs, as well as savings in physician recruitment costs, account for the significant year-over-year variance. Final reconciliations remain outstanding for Public Health expenditures (Windsor-Essex County Health Unit) as well as Social Services / Social Housing allocations (City of Windsor).

Proposed Budget

In total, the proposed budget for 2014 represents a net increase from prior year of approximately \$148,000, or less than 1%, for a total of \$25,815,610.

Savings from prior year budget in social assistance (\$756,000) and completion of the three-year commitment to International Children's Games (\$100,000) are offset by an increase in request from the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit (\$262,000), an increase in Rate Stabilization (\$500,000) to address the severe winter weather experienced in January, increase allocations to TWEPI (\$28,000) and social housing (\$16,000) and the creation of an Economic Initiative Reserve (\$200,000), to provide Council with the flexibility to address future initiatives such as sports tourism, community "bricks & mortar" requests and/or regional economic proposals.

Included within the estimates is \$500,000 (year 5 of a 10-year commitment) to fulfil capital commitments to the John McGivney Children's Centre, Hotel Dieu Grace Healthcare and the Windsor Regional Hospital.

EXTERNAL COMMITMENTS

Description

Mandatory and discretionary contributions to external boards and agencies are represented in External Commitments.

Prior Year Performance

Contributions to external boards and agencies are projected to have a net favourable variance of \$709,000 for 2013. Savings of \$500,000 in Social Services (due largely to Ontario Works caseload reductions) and \$192,000 in Social Housing costs (due to favourable mortgage renewals and increases in income) were the most significant components.

Amounts levied for rate stabilization were required to offset Pay Equity and Job Evaluation settlements throughout the organization.

Year-end financial reconciliations from the Windsor - Essex County Health Unit and the City of Windsor for Social Housing and Social Services remain outstanding.

Proposed Budget - Current Year

The proposed budget for 2014 amounts to \$25,815,610, an increase over prior year of approximately \$148,000.

Significant operating factors contributing to this net increase include:

- \$ 262,000 Windsor Essex County Health Unit budget is not yet finalized, however it proposes enhancements to staffing/services with requests for additional Provincial funding as well
- (\$ 756,000) Social Services (City of Windsor) –provincial uploading of Ontario Works costs has been partially offset by a 1% increase in Ontario Works benefits, and a shift in regional weighted assessment towards the County of Essex. Ontario Works caseloads are anticipated to level off and are budgeted at an average of 9,600 per month.
- (\$ 100,000) International Children's Game 3 year commitment ended in 2013

Proposed Budget - Current Year (cont'd)

- \$ 500,000 Rate Stabilization Pay Equity and Job Evaluation reviews continue throughout the organization. Winter Control is also anticipated to experience a unusual increase beyond the 4 year average due to an unusually high amount of activity in January 2014.
- \$ 28,000 TWEPI increased funding level as per multi-year phased in agreement
- \$ 16,000 Social Housing operational increases at the Windsor Essex County Housing Corp.

The 2014 budget continues the following long-term discretionary commitments:

- \$ 200,000 John McGivney Children's Centre Funding Request \$2,000,000 over 10 years
- \$ 200,000 Hotel Dieu Grace Hospital re: Angioplasty Unit- \$2,000,000 over 10 years
- \$ 100,000 Windsor Regional Hospital Cornerstone of Caring in support of new Mental Health Facility \$1,000,000 over 10 years

New initiatives included in the 2014 budget include:

\$ 200,000 Economic Initiatives – to allow Council to respond to opportunities to support economic growth in the County of Essex
