## CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 1998-13

Being a By-law to appoint auditors for the Town of Amherstburg.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, Sec. 86(1), R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended, requires that the Council of every Municipality shall by by-law appoint for a term of five years or less, one or more auditors who are licenced under the Public Accountancy Act to examine, audit and report on the accounts of the Corporation.

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF

## THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That the Firm of Graham, Setterington, McIntosh, Driedger and Hicks be and are hereby appointed as the Municipal Auditor for the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg.
- 2. That the Firm of Graham, Setterington, McIntosh, Driedger and Hicks be and are hereby engaged by the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg to issue and provide an opinion on the Annual Financial Statements of the Town as prepared by its Treasurer.
- 3. The appointment of the Firm of Graham, Setterington, McIntosh, Driedger and Hicks is for a term of three (3) fiscal years commencing January 1, 1998 and up to and including December 31, 2000.
- 4. The audit fee shall be \$29,000 for 1998, \$29,000 for 1999, and \$29,850 for the year 2000.
- 5. That the Municipal Auditor(s) must hold a valid Public Accountant's License as licensed under the "Public Accountancy Act".
- 6. That By-law 2343 of the Town of Amherstburg, By-law 2858 of the Township of Anderdon and By-law 83-04 of the Township of Malden, and all other By-laws and Resolutions regarding the appointment of Auditors, are hereby repealed.
- 7. That this By-law shall come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.
