

**CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG**

**BY-LAW NO. 2004-01**

**Being a by-law for prohibiting the throwing or depositing  
of rubbish on highways and for prohibiting the  
obstruction of ditches and culverts.**


**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c 25 s. 11s.s.(1) empowers Municipal Councils to pass by-laws respecting matters regarding Highways including parking and traffic on Highways;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipal Council of the Town of Amherstburg deems it expedient to pass such a by-law;

**NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. In this by-law
  - (a) "Municipality" shall mean the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg
  - (b) "Highway" shall mean a common and public street, road, highway or commons vested in the Municipality and includes a bridge or any other structure forming part of a street on, over or across which a street passes.
2. No person shall throw, place or deposit any dirt, stone, cement, asphalt, wood, plant material, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish or refuse or the carcass of any animal on any highway or bridge or ditch or culvert in the Municipality of the Town of Amherstburg.
3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offense and shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
4. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon final passing thereof.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2004.
