

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW. 2004-109

Being a by-law to authorize speed limit on certain highways in the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg

WHEREAS Subsection 2 of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O. 1990, Part 1X) authorizes the Council of the Town by by-law to prescribe a lower or higher rate of speed for motor vehicles on a highway or portion of highway under its jurisdiction.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed limit for motor vehicles on certain highways in the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg be either decreased or increased or both.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION

OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. When any highway or portion of highway set out in Schedule "A" hereto is marked in compliance with the regulation under the Highway Traffic Act the maximum rate of speed there shall be the rate of speed prescribed in the schedule.
2. The penalties provided in Subsection 14 of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this By-law.

Read a first time this 13th day of December, 2004.

Read a second time, third time and finally passed this 24th day of January, 2005.
