THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AMHERSTBURG

BY-LAW NO. 2009-04

Being a by-law to amend Bylaw 2008-03 to extend the period of time that Interim Control Zoning will be in effect respecting certain lands bounded by and abutting Sandwich Street North, Texas Road and Brunner Avenue.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg passed Bylaw 2008-03 on the 14th day of January 2008 being a bylaw to establish Interim Control Zoning respecting certain lands bounded by and abutting Sandwich Street North, Texas Road and Brunner Avenue;

AND WHEREAS Section 38(2) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13, as amended, provides that the Council of the municipality may amend an interim control bylaw to extend the period of time during which it will be in effect, provided the total period of time does not exceed two years from the date of the passing of the interim control bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg deems it necessary to extend the period of time during which the said interim control bylaw will be in effect;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN **OF AMHERSTBURG HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. That Bylaw 2008-03 be hereby amended to extend the period of time during which the interim control bylaw will be in effect to January 14, 2010.
- 2. In all other respects Bylaw 2008-03 shall remain in full force and effect.
