Minutes of a regular meeting of the Amherstburg Municipal Council held Monday, June 14, 1999.

DISCLOSURE OF PECUNIARY INTEREST:

There were no disclosures of pecuniary interest.

MINUTES:

Moved by G. Theriault, seconded by R. Pillon that the minutes of a regular meeting of the Amherstburg Municipal Council held May 25, 1999, be approved.

PETITIONS & DEPUTATIONS:

Patrick Coyle of 155 Fort St. addressed Council concerning the Envirotec facility. The plant was affecting their quality of life. He requested copies of the Property Standards by-law and related correspondence to Envirotec. He recommended weekly inspections of the property with reports issued to affected neighbors and Council. A lengthy discussion took place on the matter. Fire Chief Richard Murray and CBO Steve Brown explained their roles in Fire Code and Building Code enforcement. Administration will check if there are any load restrictions on Fort Street. Council thanked Mr. Coyle for attending.

Moved by G. Theriault, seconded by L. Fox that Valerie Butcher, of the Tri Community Figure Skating Club, be added to the list of Delegations.

Motion Carried

Dawn Hopper was present to explain a proposal to install a sign at the west end of Richmond Street on the west side of Dalhousie Street which would list the names of businesses on Richmond Street. A question and answer period followed. Ms. Hopper was thanked for attending the meeting. Louis Scodeller, addressed Council, on behalf of the North American Black Historical Museum to request that Council consider a contribution to the museum/church site in the form of modifications to the sidewalks and approaches to the museum. The estimated cost of the work is \$18,000 plus taxes. The improvements would be on Town property. In addition to this Mr. Scodeller requested that old style lighting be used to replace the existing light standard. Council thanked Mr. Scodeller for attending.

Jack Herceg presented Council with a petition for sanitary sewer service on the 3rd Concession of the former Malden Township. After a question and answer period Mr. Herceg was thanked for his attendance.

Richard Kokovai, Tobacco Policy Specialist with the Windsor Essex County Health Unit, addressed Council concerning the service he could provide to assist the municipality in the creation of a Smoking Control By-law and also offered to answer questions on the information package that was sent to Council.

Councillor Lynne Fox, as an introduction for Mr. Kokovai, updated Council on steps taken to-date, and recommended that Council endorse the forming of a Committee made up of a cross section of the community.

Councillor Theriault questioned the validity or appropriateness of some of the material provided. He surveyed a large percentage of the bar owners in Town and the response to the question of whether or not Municipal Government should impose smoking regulations, was a unanimous NO. Imposing no smoking laws would be considered dictatorial. He would not support the forming of a Committee. Mr. Kokovai explained that he appreciated the comments, however a committee would provide a forum for people to express their views on the matter. A committee does not guarantee a by-law will be passed. After further discussion Council thanked Mr. Kokovai for attending.

Mayor Hurst entered the meeting during the above discussion and assumed the chair.

Dale Scott, vice chairman Amherstburg Recreation Committee and Ed Meyer of L.P. Meyer & Associates, presented a Feasibility Study, (C98019 May 26, 1999) for a Community Centre which included a 25,700 sq. ft. NHL size second ice arena, a 14,300 sq. ft. skaters lobby, a 4,000 sq. ft. community multi-purpose room, a 7,000 sq. ft. Library and a 14,000 sq. ft. Pool and Fitness Centre. The renovated site would have a total of 355 parking spaces, 9 barrier free spaces, a bus drop zone in three locations including one bus drop zone at the main entrance. The estimated cost is \$8,590,000 plus g.s.t.

Ann Price of the Essex County YMCA stated that their organization would be interested in continuing to negotiate with the Committee to manage the Fitness and Pool part of the facility. They have 8,000 members in the County and they have no home at present. They are a very open organization, membership is denied to no one. The YMCA has the expertise and dedication needed to make a successful partnership.

When asked about the projects start and completion date, Mr. Scott stated that it could be started by August 99, and substantially completed by September 2000.

Mayor Hurst indicated that the servicing of this debt is a major consideration.

Deputy Mayor T. DiBartolomeo indicated that 75% of the debt would be serviced by new revenue. He agreed that initially it is a big price tag but we need to look into each component. Council thanked Dale and the Committee for the great amount of time and dedication put into the study.

David Fox, President of the Tri Community Minor Hockey Association, gave support to this project. He stated that more ice time is required by the community. When you include everyone in the community with a facility there is justification for the project.

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Valerie Butcher, Acting President of the Tri Community Figure Skating Club, gave statistics on the number of people involved in figure skating. They feel they could use more ice time. The project is

supported by their organization.

Moved by G. Theriault, seconded by R. Pillon that Council resume.
