Mr. Berthiaume reviewed with Council the written presentation that each Council member received.

Mayor Hurst thanked Mr. Berthiaume for attending and wished him success in his new position with the County.

Anne DiCecco addressed Council on concerns that she had in relation to the arena proposal specifications. Specific concerns were raised about

- (1) the distance between the main entrance to the nearest parking spot.
- (2) the possibility that the toboggan hill will be reduced substantially.
- (3) the necessity to be in a hurry about tendering the project without the public reviewing the plans.

Harvey Bastien, President, and Theresa Litster, Vice President of the Amherstburg Tennis League addressed Council on the need for more and improved tennis courts at H. Murray Smith Park. The Town is growing and with the arena proposal three of the five courts will be lost.

Deputy Mayor T. DiBartolomeo stated that the Engineer felt that the courts were in a state where eliminating the old and replacing with new would be more cost efficient. Also the area was needed for parking. The overall plan shows tennis courts being constructed at the south east corner of Murray Smith Park.

Ms. Litster suggested that an expert look at the old courts to determine what is needed to bring them up to standard. Mr. Bastien suggested six courts are needed to adequately serve the residents.

Discussion took place on how the existing courts got to be so deteriorated.
