Tom Hamilton addressed Council in regards to the H.M.S. Detroit Project. He stated that he has been a supporter of the project for 18 years provided that it cost the Town no money. He insisted that the town has made no commitment to paying for a seawall to provide docking. Mr. Hamilton quoted minutes from 1985 Town of Amherstburg Recreation Committee meeting.
