Three quotes have been received for dredging which range from \$295,000 to \$420,000 plus G.S.T. Mr. Krutch recommended that the tree existing quotes be disregarded at this time due to terms and conditions of work being vague.

Discussion took place on the possibility of doing dredging work on the trouble spots in order to allow immediate use and then do a complete job in the fall. Mr. Krutsch pointed out the sounding results indicate a general lack of depth rather than a few trouble spots.

Moved by M. Bezaire, seconded by A. Leardi that we receive the presentation from Dan Krutsch of BTS regarding dredging of the River Canard Channel.

As explained these street vendors set up in town only for special occasions and do not contribute to the Town as a permanent business does in such ways as taxes, jobs and community support.
