EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

In 2004 Council commenced a program to provide illumination at major street intersections within the rural areas of Amherstburg. This report provides an update on the 2006 works.

REPORT:

The 2006 approved budget provides for the expenditure of \$12,000 for the purpose of rural intersection illumination. This program has been very well received in that an additional level of comfort and safety is provided to motorists as they approach some of the rural intersections.

The 2006 intersection illumination projects were selected firstly to complete all intersection illumination along Alma street and secondly to address specific areas of concern. An additional criterion considered is the traffic counts provided by the Town's 2003 Road Needs Study. Accordingly, the following intersections were completed in 2006:

1. Alma & 7th South
2. Alma & 6th South
3. Alma & 5th North
4. Middle Sideroad & 6th
5. Middle Sideroad & 5th
6. Meloche & Lowes

Attached to this report is a plan showing all of the 19 intersections illuminated since 2004.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The above noted works were completed for \$11,708.00 which is within the budgeted amount.
