PRAYER

Reverend Kirby Breithaupt said prayer.

Mayor Hurst made the following statement on the Gordon House

The Town of Amherstburg, the H.M.S. Detroit and the Essex Region Conservation Authority had in place an Occupation and Operating Agreement for the Gordon House. The Town, because of non-compliance with the full terms of the agreement decided to take possession of the Gordon House effective April 20, 2006. The Town owns the Gordon House.

The Town plans on completing necessary repairs and maintenance to the Gordon House and determine future use of the facility. A policy is being developed by the Town to address this. H.M.S. Detroit will be offered office space in the Gordon House.

The Town of Amherstburg wishes H.M.S. Detroit well with its project.

Mayor Hurst also commented on the Federal and Provincial Governments announcement made last Friday here in our Council Chambers of the COMRIF grants to the Town of Amherstburg, the Town of Lakeshore and Pelee Township. The Town of Amherstburg was successful in receiving almost 11 million dollars for infrastructure improvements to our Wastewater system. The upgrading of our system will go a long way to improving the water in the Detroit River and the Lake system.

PRESENTATIONS

Anthony Pizans, Bev Mollard and Carl Grimstead of the Ontario Clean Water Agency gave a presentation with a focus on OCWA's services and experience in the area of quality and environmental management for the purpose of

- providing an overview of OCWA's established progress for effective Plant Management
- Outline OCWA's approach to documentation and record keeping practices.
- Describe tools developed and used by OCWA to implement and maintain a comprehensive quality management system.

As part of the report of the Walkerton Inquiry, Commissioner O'Connor recommended that all approvals for drinking water systems be incorporated into a new approval process – “The Municipal Drinking Water License” and also that owners implement a quality management approach to the operation and maintenance of their drinking water systems. Mr. Pizans and his team explained the various programs and procedures that OCWA has in place to guarantee a good product.

After a question and answer period Council thanked Mr. Pizans, Ms. Mollard and Mr. Grimstead for attending. Mr. Pizans provided a full version of the presentation which had been condensed due to time constraints.

REPORTS OF MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

Report #1

There have been many changes in the fire service in the past few years, such as the implementation of the new Fire Protection and Prevention Act. The new act mandates the municipalities to provide better services in the areas of fire protection and fire prevention activities.

The Town and the Fire Department over the years have encountered a number of issues that effect the operation of the fire department. These issues include the need for a Public Educator/Inspector, supplying fire service to Bob-lo Island, area rating of the fire service, fire station locations and an operational review of the department.

Therefore, it would be in the best interest of the town to hire a consultant to develop a Master Fire Plan that will address the above mentioned issues and also look at the future needs of the fire department.

Moved by G. Freeman, seconded by R. White that the report from Fire Chief Richard Murray, dated March 21, 2006, regarding Hiring of Consultant, be received and that the Town of Amherstburg hire T.L. Powell & Associates Ltd. to develop the Master Fire Plan for the Town of Amherstburg as this particular company has the expertise and knowledge necessary to develop a proper plan that will meet the needs of the Fire Department and the Town.

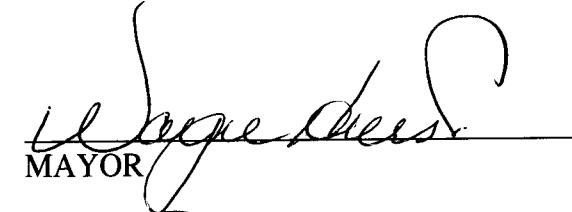
