**Report # 1**

The current Pool Enclosure Bylaw does not specifically define portable and inflatable pools which have been in the market place for several years. An amendment to the bylaw will be required to add the definition to clarify the regulation.

The Health Unit has been the Authority having jurisdiction for Part 8 On Site Sewage Systems for the Town of Amherstburg providing this service for several years. They have recently announced due to economic reasons that they will no longer be able to provide this service as of December 31, 2007. The Ontario Building Code Act requires municipalities to enforce the Ontario Building Code; therefore the Town will be the principal authority for the enforcement for this section of the OBC.
