A pre-commitment of the 2021 Budget for Southeast Quadrant engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$435,533 BE APPROVED including \$354,242 in the Wastewater budget centre and \$81,291 in the Water budget centre to be funded from developer contributions and local service charges as outlined in the report dated

July 27, 2020 with the amounts to be collected after 2020 to be interim financed by transfers from the Wastewater Capital Reserve and Water Capital Reserve respectively until collected in accordance with the MOU; and,
